



TRAILER RACE RULES 2024

TRAILER RACES ARE VERY ENTERTAINING AND CAN BE VERY DANGEROUS. IN ORDER TO KEEP THE COST OF CAR PREPARATION DOWN AND STAY SAFE, PARTICIPANTS NEED TO REMEMBER THIS IS A RACE TO THE CHECKERED FLAG AND IS IN NO WAY A HIGH SPEED DERBY.

- Compact Cars – 4 Cylinders
 - Compact Cars – 4 Cylinders AWD
 - Mid Size Cars – 6 Cylinders
 - Mid Size Cars Powder Puff - 6 Cylinders
 - Mid Size Cars Youth (18 years and under) – 6 Cylinders
 - Full Size Cars – 6 Cylinders 110-1/2” wheel base or larger
 - Full Size Cars – 8 Cylinders 110-1/2” wheel base or larger
 - Compact Trucks/SUV – 6 Cylinders 2X4 Roll bars mandatory
 - Compact Trucks/SUV – 6 Cylinders 4X4 Roll bars mandatory
 - Compact Trucks/SUV – 8 Cylinders – Roll bars mandatory
 - Full Size Trucks - 2X4 – Roll bars mandatory
 - Full Size Trucks - 4X4 – Roll bars mandatory
 - Campers/Motorhomes/Buses
1. All vehicles need to remove any excess plastic or flammable material.
 2. **All vehicles are required to have a visible number on both sides of vehicle and a roof sign. Numbers that are hard to read could result in laps not being counted. Lap counters are not responsible for errors due to this infraction.**
 3. A 12”x12” hole in the engine hood for extinguishing fires is required.
 4. Windshield bars are highly recommended.
 5. Helmets and seatbelts are mandatory.
 6. Any DOT tire is allowed. Beads on tires may be screwed to rims. No implement tires.
 7. No alcohol in pits.
 8. Each vehicle must have a hitch of some sort or chain to connect trailers.
 9. No passengers.
 10. Each participant is required to bring a trailer that includes a tongue and wheels.
 11. Trailers will be placed by size of vehicle-not automatically the one you bring. Officials have final decisions on all trailers.
 12. It is the drivers’ responsibility to securely mount the appropriate size trailer to their vehicle.
 13. Heats and features will have no more than 12 vehicles.
 14. Each heat will consist of 6 laps and each feature will consist of 12 laps, as time allows.
 15. All participants are required to finish with their trailer connected. Any vehicles without a trailer will be disqualified.
 16. All payouts and trophies will be awarded at the following IMP event or mailed.
 17. Each participant will receive corresponding points for place received towards Overall Points Champion.
 18. Trucks and trailers only in the pit area. No extra vehicles allowed in pit area.
 19. All drivers intentionally smashing into other vehicles will be disqualified for the remainder of the event.
