

TRAILER RACES ARE VERY ENTERTAINING AND CAN BE VERY DANGEROUS. IN ORDER TO KEEP THE COST OF CAR PREPARATION DOWN AND STAY SAFE, PARTICIPANTS NEED TO REMEMBER THIS IS A RACE TO THE CHECKERED FLAG AND IS IN NO WAY A HIGH SPEED DERBY.

- Compact Cars 4 Cylinders
- Compact Cars 4 Cylinders AWD
- Mid Size Cars 6 Cylinders
- Mid Size Cars Powder Puff 6 Cylinders
- Mid Size Cars Youth (18 years and under) 6 Cylinders
- Full Size Cars 6 Cylinders 110-1/2" wheel base or larger
- Full Size Cars 8 Cylinders 110-1/2" wheel base or larger
- Compact Trucks/SUV 6 Cylinders 2X4
- Compact Trucks/SUV 6 Cylinders 4X4
- Compact Trucks/SUV 8 Cylinders
- Full Size Trucks 2X4
- Full Size Trucks 4X4
- Campers/Motorhomes/Buses
- 1. HALO AND DOOR BAR MANDATORY FOR ALL CLASSES.
- 2. All vehicles need to remove any excess plastic or flammable material.
- 3. All vehicles are required to have a visible number on both sides of vehicle and a roof sign. Numbers that are hard to read could result in laps not being counted. Lap counters are not responsible for errors due to this infraction.
- 4. A 12"x12" hole in the engine hood for extinguishing fires is required.
- 5. Windshield bars are highly recommended.
- 6. Helmets and seatbelts are mandatory.
- 7. Any DOT tire is allowed. Beads on tires may be screwed to rims. No implement tires.
- 8. No alcohol in pits.
- 9. Each vehicle must have a hitch of some sort or chain to connect trailers.
- 10. No passengers.
- 11. Each participant is required to bring a trailer that includes a tongue and wheels.
- 12. Trailers will be placed by size of vehicle-not automatically the one you bring. Officials have final decisions on all trailers.
- 13. It is the drivers' responsibility to securely mount the appropriate size trailer to their vehicle.
- 14. Heats and features will have no more than 12 vehicles.
- 15. Each heat will consist of 6 laps and each feature will consist of 12 laps, as time allows.
- 16. All participants are required to finish with their trailer connected. Any vehicles without a trailer will be disqualified.
- 17. All payouts and trophies will be will be awarded at the following IMP event or mailed.
- 18. Each participant will receive corresponding points for place received towards Overall Points Champion.
- 19. Trucks and trailers only in the pit area. No extra vehicles allowed in pit area.
- 20. All drivers intentionally smashing into other vehicles will be disqualified for the remainder of the event.
